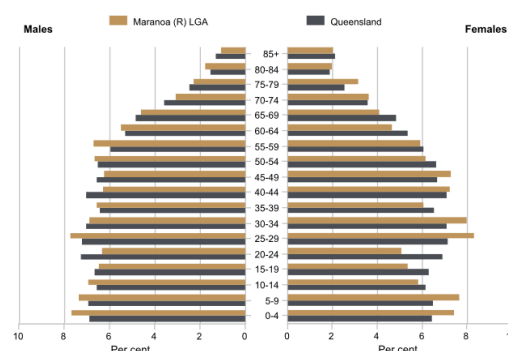


Figure 4 Estimated resident population by age and sex, Maranoa (R) LGA and Queensland, 30 June 2015p
